
- Loudspeaker positioning: Angle from 0 30° / Direction to the side +/- 45°


SAFETY NOTES


- If the product is used at productions and events (professional use) be aware of national regulatory requirements.
- Observe the local mounting regulations (they may deviate from the examples presented here).
- Use 4 screws/anchors for the ceiling mount
- Only use trained technicians to install the system
- Only mount on suitable ceilings with the corresponding assembly materials (not included in the delivery); Example see Point **2** Observe the placement instructions provided by the anchor manufacturer.
- Ceilings that are too weak or have electrical and water conduits are not suitable. In case of doubt consult a qualified technician.
- Ensure that the screws are tight and load-bearing, in particular as regards the setting of the loudspeaker angle.
- Careful and attentive handling is required when adjusting the stand due to the possibility of pinching or wedging your hand.
- In case of damage the product may not be used.


